



## Guidelines for Poster Presentations

Posters should succinctly state the Objective, Design, Materials and Methods, Results and Conclusion. Lettering should be large enough to be viewed from 1.2 m (4 ft) away.

Posters will be displayed on 200cm high x 80cm wide poster boards. Pushpins will be provided at each poster board and Velcro will be available at the Registration Desk for those who wish to use this as an alternative. Use of adhesive tapes is prohibited in order to avoid damaging the poster boards. Please do not mount the presentation material on heavy board, as the pushpins and Velcro may not be sufficient to hold it in position.

You will be assigned a poster number and your poster is to be displayed on the board which coincides with your assigned number. You will find your poster number in the final program which you will receive upon arrival at the symposium. Please be advised that audio-visual equipment will not be allowed at the poster presentations.

**Presenters are expected to set up their posters prior to the commencement of the Symposium presentations (by 2 pm Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> September). Presenters must be available at their poster to answer questions during the two allocated poster session times.**

### **Poster Session One – 3:40-4:20 on Thursday, 10 September**

Please ensure you put up your poster before the commencement of the Symposium presentations

### **Poster Session Two – 10:20-11:00 on Friday, 11 September**

Posters may be removed at the conclusion of the Symposium presentations (1 pm, Friday 11<sup>th</sup> September)

*Note the Poster sessions are held during the afternoon tea and morning tea sessions on Thursday and Friday, respectively. All refreshments for morning and afternoon tea will be located at the poster venue. The Symposium organisers will not be responsible for loss or damage to posters left up after the scheduled take down time. The Symposium organisers also will not be responsible for theft of materials displayed in the poster room.*
